Guidelines

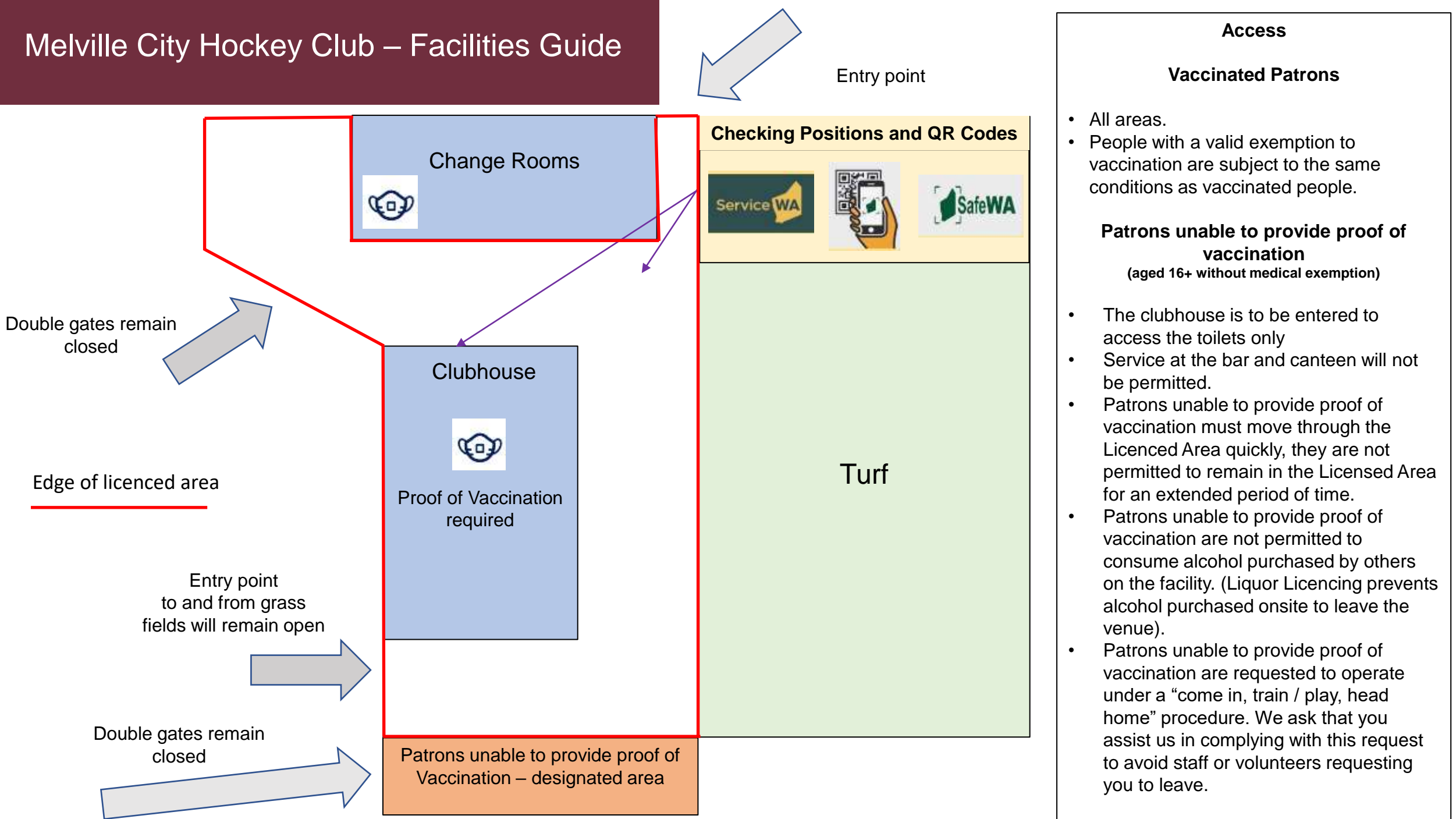
- We ask all patrons review the map and use the appropriate areas as highlighted.
- Upon entry into our facility, all patrons **must** check-in using the Safe WA or Service WA app.
- On entry you will receive a stamp when you have provided your proof of vaccination.
- Whilst every effort will be made to check patrons on entry it is also your responsibility to provide proof of vaccination and receive a stamp.
- Spot checks will be conducted by designated hockey club staff, and potentially City of Melville Security staff or WA Police.
- You must wear a mask in the clubhouse at all times unless consuming food or beverages.
- You must always wear a mask in changerooms. No food or alcoholic beverages are permitted in changerooms.
- A designated area for patrons unable to provide proof of vaccination is highlighted on the map.
- Any patrons refusing to follow the guideline will be asked to leave.
- Please respect our volunteer staff at all times.

Access

Vaccinated Patrons

- All areas.
- People with a valid exemption to vaccination are subject to the same conditions as vaccinated people.

Patrons unable to provide proof of vaccination

(aged 16+ without medical exemption)

- The clubhouse is to be entered to access the toilets only
- Service at the bar and canteen will not be permitted.
- Patrons unable to provide proof of vaccination must move through the Licenced Area quickly, they are not permitted to remain in the Licensed Area for an extended period of time.
- Patrons unable to provide proof of vaccination are not permitted to consume alcohol purchased by others on the facility. (Liquor Licencing prevents alcohol purchased onsite to leave the venue).
- Patrons unable to provide proof of vaccination are requested to operate under a "come in, train / play, head home" procedure. We ask that you assist us in complying with this request to avoid staff or volunteers requesting you to leave.
